What are the Roadblocks to Friendship?

John 15:12-15

It starts with friendship:

What does the Bible say about friendship? The subject of friend- ship appears throughout the Bible, especially in John 15:12–15.

What is our model for friendship? "Greater love has no man than this..."

Things prevent us from building these kinds of friendships.

Roadblock #1: Selfishness/Pride

When we were kids, if we had something that was ours, more than likely there was a time when we shouted, "Mine!"

Roadblock #2: Jealousy

A second possible roadblock to fellowship and friendship is jealousy. Jealousy is pride's sibling.

Roadblock #3: Unforgiveness

The third roadblock to fellowship and friendship happens a lot today.

Matthew 6:14–15 (ESV) says, "For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

Roadblock #4: Disunity

The fourth roadblock to fellowship and friendship is what 0x- ford's calls *disunity*. This is defined as "having disagreement and conflict."
